

16TH ANNUAL HERBIE'S HOME "TOWN LOOP" (HHL)

Saturday, August 20, 2022

Downtown Bellefonte, PA

4-mile run/walk beginning @ 8:30AM

Herbie's Home "Town Loop" is a 4-mile run/walk held in honor of Jeremy Herbstritt, a Bellefonte local and Penn State alum killed in the Virginia Tech school shootings in 2007. Funds raised from *Herbie's Hometown Loop* will stay in the community and be used to help a recent Bellefonte graduate, Hunter Henney in his battle with thyroid cancer. Hunter was recently diagnosed with what was initially thyroid cancer, requiring surgery and other medical treatments, which has since spread to other areas of his body. Payment for things such as medication, medical care, transportation, in addition to regular costs of daily life, has had an impact on the family.

COURSE: The 4 mile course is wheel measured, and begins at the intersection of High and Spring Streets in downtown Bellefonte. The 4-mile loop traverses around the perimeter of downtown Bellefonte (i.e. "TOWN LOOP"). It finishes on High Street in front of URBN Express.

ENTRY FEES: \$25 registration fee plus you are encouraged to bring a canned good donation for the local food bank for the 4-mile run/walk by Wednesday, August 17th. Race day: \$30 registration. Additional donations for Hunter Henney will gladly be accepted.
